Timing	Welcome and Introduction	Resource
5 mins	 Welcome and Introduction Provide Housekeeping – Fire Exits, mobile phones on vibrate Provide a summary of what the workshop will involve and the expectations from the participants Introduce yourselves - facilitation team, host team and participants. Timing	Familiarisation to Mannequin & equipment	
5 mins	Introduce students to mannequin & capabilities	Local faculty to familiarise the students to the
		environment/ mannequin/actors. Can use the
		familiarisation video, to guide the local faculty, if
		needed.









Timing	Simulation	
15 mins	BAT CALL - 6yo known asthmatic, RR 38, HR 170, Very wheezy , three lots of ventolin via spacer, ETA 2 minutes	
	OR Zara, 6 month old girl with 3 days of fevers, cough and increasing shortness of breath. Her mother has noticed she has had difficulty feeding this morning.	
Timing	Debrief	
20 mins	Changing priorities with deteriorating child, recognizing lack of improvement (deterioration)	
	Management of the child with bronchiolitis or asthma	
	Team work and communication.	
	Communication with mother and child in the resuscitation bay.	
	Handover to senior staff via telephone input.	
Timing	Summary	
5 mins	Call for assistance in anticipation of clinical and logistic need.	
	Planning & preparation are both long and short term factors.	
	Clear, concise communication is the responsibility of all members of the team.
