Case Summary: Clark Kent, 45 year old man presents with resolved chest pain of 5 minutes duration. Nil previous history, though strong family history of cardiac disease at young age. As his pain has now resolved, he needs early investigation and reassurance.		Participant Briefing: Clark Kent, presents with 5 minutes of chest pain. He has been triaged category 2 to an acute bed. His pain has now resolved.

Initial Presentation Rhythm SR HR 70 BP 137/80 RR 12 SPO2 98% Temp 37.2 Conscious level Alert	Initial assessment Perform A-G assessment of patient Apply monitoring to patient Take automatic NIBP	Pause and discuss the initial set up of a patient onto monitoring, including automatic NIBP. Discuss when monitoring should be used in the emergency department During pause question when to take manual NIBP, consider having a participant demonstrate this skill.
Progression Observations unchanged	Recommence scenario Participants should continue with their assessment including taking a 12 lead ECG ECG should be shown to medical staff, and handover given	Once ECG performed medical staff should be sent into scenario to look at ECG if not requested by nursing staff. Discuss NSW Health guidelines re time to ECG Pause and discuss – taking an ECG including lead placement, handover to medical staff (ISBAR) Consider need for this skill to be demonstrated by faculty or participant during the pause.
